She helps coordinate the North Carolina anti-trafficking taskforce, called RIPPLE, and is also organizing the Triangle Rapid Response Team to assist victims of trafficking in the Triangle area.

Originally from New York, she attended Grinnell College in Iowa, where she received a bachelor's degree in Spanish and Linguistics. Before coming to North Carolina, she worked as a paralegal at an immigration law firm in Chicago and on a political campaign in Iowa.
